Easy and Unusual Home Décor Quilt Projects Workshop Table Runners, Placemats and Small Wall Quilt

6 hour workshop for advanced beginner to experienced quilters
Learn an exciting technique that yields dramatic results.

Students choose to make one of the following patterns in the workshop:

Lucky Seven – a table runner and 6 place mats



A table runner and 6 placemats out of the SAME strip sets. No Templates! Plus a bonus of 6 coasters. Fat Quarter Friendly. Students just sew two each of three simple strip sets and have enough to make all seven items and the coasters. And this is basic sewing – cut straight lines and sew straight seams. Once they learn this easy technique, they will want to make a set for every season. Great gifts.

Twofer – a table runner & a table topper (or a wall quilt)



Create TWO extraordinary art quilts out of the same strip sets. One can be used as a table runner or one as a table topper. This easy technique uses strip piecing – no templates! Students learn directional sewing and how to construct a quilt that is not a square. Other quilts in a variety of shapes that have been made with this technique will be shown and discussed.

One for the Money – a dramatic wall quilt



ONE fabric (excluding the border), ONE block design, ONE technique and No strip sets! Choose a bold stripe and say goodbye to sewing strip sets. Fast and easy and the results are dazzling.

These 3 projects use a similar technique but each has its own special procedure. Students will make the quilt for the pattern that they have selected. At the end of the class, the variations found in each of the patterns will be demonstrated and discussed: Three workshops in one!
